We are two local charities who work with paid staff and volunteers and are overseen by local trustee bodies, both looking for several new trustees.

We are especially interested in those with their own lived experience of the refugee and asylum system who want to contribute back in this way.

LCoS would particularly welcome interest from anyone with experience in HR for a small charity employment or with expertise in the use of social media for publicity

After18 is seeking trustees with leadership experience and would particularly welcome interest from people with a fundraising or HR background, or with legal knowledge related to charities and employment. We are also looking for trustees with media or marketing skills.
